HAMPDEN CONSERVATION COMMISSION

SPECIAL CONSERVATION MEETING

April 24, 2018

<u>Attendance</u>: Chairman, Bonnie Geromini and Conservation Board Members Judy McKinley Brewer, Phil Grant, Ted Zebert, Andrew Netherwood and Tim Hanley.

Not in Attendance: Branden Garvey was not in attendance.

Chairman, Bonnie Geromini, opened the special meeting at 6:00 p.m.

New Business:

Minnechaug Land Trust - Conservation Restrictions – Judy reviewed a document for Minnechaug Land Trust regarding the conservation restrictions they were looking to place on a 39 acre parcel, located on the westerly side of North Road (Parcel ID 28-18-0). She explained that previously the document was only signed by the Select Board, but now legally the Conservation Commission has to sign it.

The Commission voted unanimously in favor of accepting the conservation restrictions as presented. The conservation restrictions were signed by the Commission members and Eva notarized both copies. Judy will be passing these copies on to the Land Trust lawyer.

<u>Hampden Highway Department</u> – Request for Determination of Applicability Replacement of the existing storm drain system on Wilbraham Road, from Allen Street to Raymond Drive. Mark Langone appeared before the Board on this matter.

This matter was continued from the 4/18/2018 meeting. After some discussion at the last meeting, the Commission scheduled a site visit. The Commission met with Mr. Langone on 4/24/2018 to complete a site visit.

Mark informed the Commission that the proposed work will include the replacement of all existing catch basins and underground piping. There will be no change to the direction of the flow, number of basins, or the outfall discharge locations.

Bonnie made a motion to issue a Negative Determination. Ted seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

Bonnie informed Mr. Langone that the Conservation clerk will send him the paperwork in the morning.

<u>Recommendation Letter</u> – The Conservation clerk informed the Commission that one of the members, Branden Garvey, had an interview scheduled for a Conservation related job after graduating with an Environmental Science major. She prepared a recommendation letter for Branden, which was reviewed and signed by the Commission.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:18 p.m.
