- I understand that verbal and physical abuse including profanity and foul language is not to be tolerated against anyone in this league / organization.
- I understand that racial epithets or negative innuendo related to a person / player's race, religion or ethnicity would not be tolerated.
- I will respect all officials, coaches and volunteers.
- I will not create conflict by slander, malicious rumors or threats, nor will I entice others to do so.
- I will return my players clean uniform, in good condition, promptly to the coach at the end of the season

By signing below, I understand the Hampden Park & Recreation Department has adopted a **ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY**. If I violate any of these Codes of Ethics it will result in suspension of my/our participation from any Hampden activity for not less than the balance of the current season, or as determined by the Hampden Parks & Recreation Department.
