<u>Monthly Financials</u> – The board reviewed the ledger for the four department accounts. They asked if the sports finances could be organized by calendar year, not fiscal year.

<u>Summer Program</u> – After a discussion about the current operations and program structure, the board agreed to restructure the summer program. All seasonal employees need to reapply every year to work as a counselor. Carrie will bring the new framework for the summer program to the next meeting.
