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### ADVISORY COMMITTEE TOWN OF HAMPDEN, MASSACHUSETTS REPORT OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Again this year the Advisory Committee has spent most of it's time trying to find a way to do more with less in these times of reduced state aid to cities and towns and a slow economy. As a result of these problems our unappropriated and available funds account has been depleated to less than \$50,000 and our town employees have gone without increases in compensation.

In preparation for the FY 1993 we have asked town departments to prepare "Needs" budgets. Although the towns financial position is as stringent as ever we feel, that this is the best way of discussing what is really required to operate the town. This has resulted in large increases in the requests of many departments including gasoline, landfill, police, highway and the schools. Most budgets do not include a request for salary increases which must also be addressed.

We urge you to attend and participate in the Advisory

Committee budget hearing which will be held on March 16, 1992 at

8:00 PM at the Town House, so that we can discuss these requests.

This will help us all to be better prepared for Town Meeting which will be held on April 27, 1992.
